On behalf of the Board of Governors of the National Association of Unemployment Insurance Appeals Professionals (NAUIAP), I would like to invite you to consider joining our organization with a state membership.

State membership pays for all of your state's lower and higher authority appeals hearing officials, legal staff assigned to UI appeals cases, UI Directors and board members to participate as members of NAUIAP. State membership dues are based upon the size of your state staff.

For states with 25 employees or less, the state membership fee is \$500.00 per year.

For states with 26 to 75 employees or less, the state membership fee is \$1000.00 per year.

For states with more than 75 employees, the state membership fee is \$1500.00.

Annual individual dues are \$50.00 per person per year. The savings for states are significant and will allow additional members of your UI appeals staffs to participate in the organization. Benefits include website access, conference and research materials for members only and a member chat forum. Additionally, states with state memberships pay less to attend the annual training conference.
